CUI Basic vs CUI Specified

Basic – the authorizing law, regulation, or government-wide policy does not set out specific handling or dissemination controls. *Example marking - CUI*

Specified - the authorizing law, regulation, or government-wide policy requires specific handling or dissemination controls. *For example, Export Controlled is a specified category and requires both a warning statement and distribution statement in accordance with the laws, regulations, or government-wide policies governing the information. Non-DoD agencies may apply specified markings - CUI//SP-EXPT*

Information must fall within a law, regulation, or government-wide policy before it can be considered CUI. The applicable authorities for each CUI category are listed on the web page.

OPSEC is not the default CUI category. The information must be on the organization’s critical information list (CIL) before the OPSEC category can be used.

Distribution statements are required with CUI categories Controlled Technical Information (CTI) and Export Controlled (EXPT). A limited dissemination control (LDC) is used with all other categories.
